A Triceratops sees 2 trees. Then 1 more tree appears. How many trees does the Triceratops see? $2 + 1 = \underline{\quad}$

There are 3 Stegosaurus dinosaurs playing. 2 more Stegosaurus join them. How many Stegosaurus are there now? $3 + 2 = \underline{\quad}$

3

A T-Rex finds 4 eggs. Then it finds 1 more egg. How many eggs does it have? $4 + 1 = \underline{\quad}$

4

In a dinosaur nest, there are 2 baby dinosaurs. 3 more babies hatch. How many baby dinosaurs are in the nest? $2 + 3 = \underline{\quad}$

5

A Brachiosaurus eats 5 plants. Then it eats 2 more plants. How many plants did it eat? $5 + 2 = \underline{\quad}$

6

There are 1 Pterodactyl flying in the sky. 4 more Pterodactyls join it. How many are flying? $1 + 4 = \underline{\quad}$

7

A dinosaur footprint has 3 toes. Another footprint has 2 toes. How many toes altogether? $3 + 2 = \underline{\quad}$

There are 4 dinosaurs at the watering hole. 3 more dinosaurs come to drink. How many dinosaurs are at the watering hole? $4 + 3 = \underline{\quad}$
