ANSWER

30¢ total; yes, she will have enough with 5¢ left over

ANSWER

60¢

During a rainy day adventure, Freddy the Fox collected coins from under wet leaves. He found 4 nickels and 3 pennies. How much money did Freddy discover on his treasure hunt?

ANSWER

23¢
