ANSWER

6 cents

2

Summer is selling ice cream at the beach to earn money for a sandcastle contest. He sells 5 ice creams for 25 cents each. How much money does Summer earn?

ANSWER

\$1.25 or 125 cents

3

Fall is collecting acorns to trade with her friends. She found 2 quarters in the forest. How many dimes does that equal?

ANSWER

5 dimes

4

Winter is buying hot chocolate ingredients for his snow day party. Hot chocolate mix costs 30 cents and marshmallows cost 20 cents. How much will Winter spend altogether?

ANSWER

50 cents

5

Spring starts her rainy day lemonade stand with 2 dollars. A customer buys lemonade for 75 cents. How much money does Spring have left?

ANSWER

\$1.25 or 125 cents

6

Summer wants to buy a beach ball that costs 85 cents. He has 3 quarters and 1 dime. Does he have enough money? How much extra or how much more does he need?

ANSWER

Yes, he has enough. He has 5 cents extra.

7

Fall is saving leaves in a jar and gets paid 10 cents for each leaf she collects. If she collects 8 leaves, how much money will she earn?

ANSWER

80 cents

8

Winter is buying supplies for his ice sculpture. Paint costs 45 cents and brushes cost 35 cents. How much more does the paint cost than the brushes?

ANSWER

10 cents
