ANSWER

35 coconuts

ANSWER

28 bananas

Ellie the elephant is stacking leaves for her nest. She stacks 4 piles of 10 leaves each and then adds 6 more leaves on top. What is the total number of leaves in Ellie's stack?

ANSWER

46 leaves

ANSWER

53 seeds

29 gems
