Hercules is collecting golden apples from the Garden of the Hesperides. He collects 24 apples on Monday, 18 apples on Tuesday, and 15 apples on Wednesday. How many golden apples has Hercules collected in total?

ANSWER

57 apples

2

Athena is weaving tapestries in her temple. She can weave 8 tapestries per day. If she works for 6 days straight, how many complete tapestries will Athena have finished?

ANSWER

48 tapestries

3

Poseidon's treasure chest contains 200 golden coins. He decides to divide his treasure equally among 5 sea nymphs as rewards for helping him. How many coins does each sea nymph receive?

ANSWER

40 coins each

A pegasus (a magical flying horse) flies 35 miles in the morning and 42 miles in the afternoon while helping Perseus complete his quest. What is the total distance the pegasus flew?

ANSWER

77 miles

5

Hephaestus forges 12 magical swords on Monday, 15 swords on Tuesday, and 13 swords on Wednesday in his volcano workshop. How many swords did he forge altogether?

ANSWER

40 swords

6

Apollo is arranging 96 golden laurels into equal groups to decorate 8 different temples. How many laurels will go in each temple?

ANSWER

12 laurels per temple

Theseus must navigate through 3 different mazes in the Labyrinth. The first maze takes him 28 minutes, the second takes 35 minutes, and the third takes 22 minutes. How much total time does Theseus spend in the Labyrinth?

ANSWER

85 minutes

8

Artemis is preparing for a grand hunt. She has 144 arrows to distribute equally among 9 hunters in her group. How many arrows will each hunter receive?

ANSWER

16 arrows per hunter
